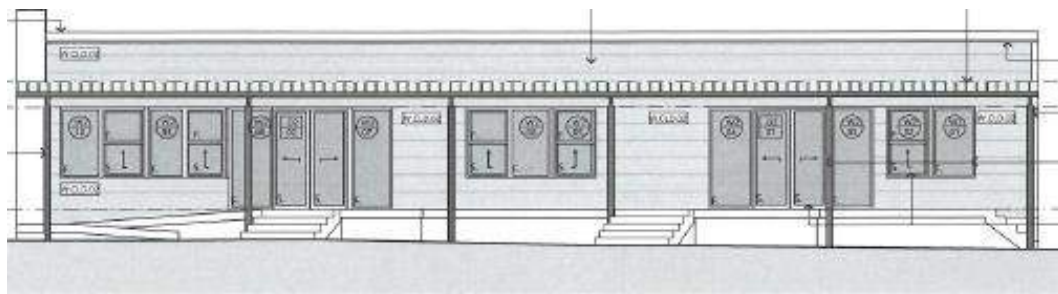

FROM THE PRINCIPAL
